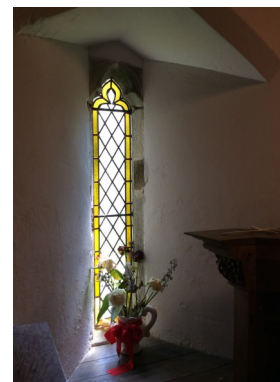

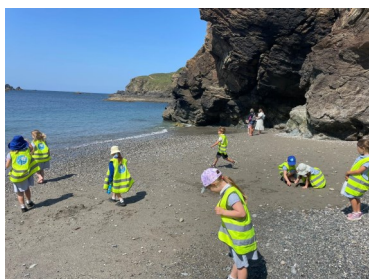
Pentecost


